Ambiance

Built in 1927, the Mayflower Park Hotel has been beautifully restored, retaining the ambiance of a classic European hotel. Crystal chandeliers, lofty ceilings, stained glass windows and fresh flowers contribute to the feeling of old world charm. Lobby antiques include a 1776 Grandfather clock and an 1810 English Regency breakfront. The exterior of the building has some of the finest terra cotta detailing in Seattle.

Location

The Mayflower Park Hotel occupies one of Seattle’s finest shopping and business locations. The hotel is centrally located in the heart of downtown and opens directly into the Westlake Center and its eighty specialty shops and restaurants. From there you can ride the Monorail to the Seattle Center and the Space Needle or take a complimentary shuttle via the underground tunnel to Pioneer Square, the International District, the Safeco Field or the Convention Center. Two of Seattle’s finest retail stores, the Macy’s and the flagship Nordstrom are located right next to the hotel. The historic Pike Place Market and Seattle’s waterfront are just a short five minute walk away.

Guest Room Accommodations

There are 171 guest rooms including 19 luxury suites with King, Queen or Double Queen beds. Many of the top floor rooms have beautiful views of the city. Most of the suites come equipped with wet bars and refrigerators. All guest rooms are non-smoking.

Guest rooms are tastefully appointed in classic color schemes with custom comforters, drapes and artwork designed and tailored for each room, many with columned headboards and armoires in traditional Queen Anne styling.

All rooms include a color television with remote control, free HBO, CNN, ESPN and pay-per-view movies, AM/FM radio clock, irons and ironing boards, data ports, voice mail, hair dryers, sound insulated windows that open and individual heat and air conditioning controls. There is no charge for children 18 and under when sharing a room with their parents. Complimentary high speed wireless Internet access is available throughout the hotel.

Dining and Relaxing

Oliver’s, Seattle’s most popular and elegant downtown bar serves your favorite beverage, light lunch and hors d’oeuvres in a casual setting of crystal chandeliers and tall paned windows looking out on the street scene.
