

### **Seattle Light Rail Directions:**

From the baggage claim, take the escalator up one level and cross the driveway via the glass walking sky bridges located one level above baggage claim, to the 4<sup>th</sup> level of the parking garage.

Follow the signs to the Light Rail walking north along the walkway of the airport parking structure to the light rail station.

This is approximately a 7 to 10 minute walk, about 600 yards

Enter the station and purchase your ticket for the light rail, (cash or credit card) from the machine on the 1st level and proceed up to the 2nd level to catch the train.

The train runs every 7 minutes in peak time and every 10 minutes midday time. The ride is approximately 40 minutes.

The ticket arrangement is on the “honor system” so you may not be asked to show one. However, if you are asked and you do not have one the fine can be expensive.

Ride the train to the “**Westlake Center**” station, 2 levels underground in Downtown Seattle.

Exit the train at **Westlake station**, ride the escalator or elevator one level up to the mezzanine level of the station. Walk to your left, the walkway will fork and you want to bear right. Follow the signs for Macy’s/Pine Street and then ride the escalator or elevator up to the street level.

Once on the street level (you will be on Pine Street) turn left on Pine Street, walk to the corner & turn left on 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The entrance to the hotel is at the end of the block, across from Macy’s at 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Olive Way.

**The fare is \$3.25 per person one way.**

### **Mayflower Park Hotel to Seatac**

Exit the Hotel via 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. exit.

Turn left and walk to the corner of 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Pine Street.

Turn right and cross 4<sup>th</sup> avenue on Pine Street and you will be in front of Macy’s.

In the middle of the block there is an entrance to the Light rail tunnel via escalator or elevator.

Go down one level and purchase your ticket in the machine to SeaTac Airport.

You will go down one more level to the platform via the stairs or the elevator just past the stairs on the left for the southbound train.

**The fare is \$3.25 per person one way.**

Note: the airport stop is the next to the last stop.
